

**Regulation amending, for the third time,
the Regulation Implementing the Chemical Weapons Convention
(3rd AmendCWCIR)**

as of 5 July 2011

Having regard to Article 2, paragraph 1 and 3 and Article 3 of the Act Implementing the Chemical Weapons Convention of 2 August 1994 (Federal Law Gazette I, p. 1954), the Federal Government has issued this regulation:

Article 1

The Regulation Implementing the Chemical Weapons Convention of 20 November 1996 (BGBl. I, p. 1794), last amended by Article 1 of the regulation of 16 May 2001 (BGBl. I, p. 888) is amended as follows:

1. In section 4 para. 1 sub-paragraph 5 the words “of a chemical” is substituted by the words “of chemicals”.
2. In section 8 para. 2 sentence 2 the words “applications and” are inserted in front of the word “declarations”.
3. Section 9 para. 3 is revised as follows:

“(3) Sections 2, 4 and 6 shall not apply if the concentration of chemicals

1. of Schedule 2 nos. 1 to 3 is 1 per cent or less, or
 2. of Schedule 2 nos. 4 to 14, or of Schedule 3 is 30 per cent or less
- in a mixture.”

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its announcement,
